BOBBY PIATT by Dean Eagle The Louisville Times

About 19 years ago Bobby Piatt took over a tennis tournament to help a friend. It was supposed to be only a temporary chore in tennis promotion but Piatt was "hooked." The attachment was mutual.

It was obvious from the start that Piatt was good for tennis and tennis was good for Piatt.

Since that temporary stint, tennis has become a solid avocation for Piatt and at times has given his vocation keen competition.

Piatt has held these positions:

—Secretary of the Southern Lawn Tennis Association for six years (1954-1959). (He has been elected again for 1960).

—President of the Southern Lawn Tennis Association in 1952 and 1953. While president, he originated "Southern Tennis News" of which he was editor for seven years through 1958.

—Chairman of the U.S.L.T.A. Junior Davis Cup Committee for seven years—three years under U.S.L.T.A. President James H. Bishop, two years under Renville H. McMann, and two years under the current president, Victor Denny.

—Regional vice president of the U.S.L.T.A. (southern region of Florida, Middle Atlantic and Southern Associations) for past three years. Prior to that he was U.S.L.T.A. delegate-at-large.

—A member of the U.S.L.T.A. executive committee for the past five years.

—Chairman of the Louisville Junior Davis and Wightman Cup committees from 1948 through 1953, assisted by Doc Kelsall.

—One of the three founders (with Doc Kelsall and Jerry McNerney) in 1952 of the Kentucky Tennis Patrons Foundation. He served first as Secretary, then president, and now is a director.

—Chairman of the Louisville Municipal Tennis Advisory Committee for the past two years.

—One of the originators of the Kentucky State Tennis Association, one of eight districts of the S.L.T.A.

If it's tennis title, chances are "Bobby" has had it.

As for some of his bigger tournaments, Piatt was general chairman of the Southern Tennis Championships at the Louisville Boat Club in 1941 and in 1950.

He was co-chairman with Doc Kelsall in putting on Kentucky State Open Championships from 1947 through 1959, the Southern Tennis Championship in 1950, Davis Cup ties matching Japan and the United States in 1951 and Australia and Brazil in 1955, and the Kentucky State Junior Championships from 1952 through 1959.

Piatt has accumulated a roomful of records during tenures as tournament manager and member of committees. He is a very methodical bookkeeper, saving and filing reports and records necessary in helping a tournament not to make the same mistake twice or, to repeat successful gimmicks.

"My employers have been very considerate during many trips over the years," said Piatt. "Sometimes I have put on

tournaments and attended committee meetings on my vacations and on many occasions they have given me time off."

Piatt is in the sales department of the Lanham Hardwood Flooring Company.

Piatt regards the Davis Cup tie in 1955 as his top single promotion.

What would he rather do than eat?

"My favorite pastime is talking tennis—especially local tennis with those familiar with our problems and achievements. Next I suppose I would prefer to put on a tournament. Then, if I'm not talking about a tournament or helping put on a tournament, I'd rather see one."

Bobby plays "a fair game" but doesn't have too much time.

The greatest star?

"I don't think anybody could match Bill Tilden's all-round game."

And the future?

"Well, I guess I'll get married some day and let somebody else have all these records. I'm not as young as I used to be (45) and staying up all night planning a tournament and working all day putting it on takes a lot out of me."
