CATEGORIES OF PLAYERS

At its Annual Meeting, February 8, 1969, the USLTA amended Article III of its Constitution to create new definitions of categories for players under its jurisdiction, as follows:

Article III—Conditions Governing Tennis Players

Sec. 1. The following categories of tennis players are recognized as within the jurisdiction of the USLTA:

a. AMATEURS

b. PLAYERS

Sec. 2. Any tennis player is an AMATEUR who does not receive and has not received, directly or indirectly, pecuniary advantage by the playing, teaching, demonstrating, or pursuit of the game, except as expressly permitted by the USLTA.

An AMATEUR will not be deemed to have received pecuniary advantage by reason of: (1) Being reimbursed for reasonable expenses actually incurred by him in connection with his participation in a tournament, match, or exhibition, or (2) being the recipient of a scholarship or other benefits authorized by his school (high school, college, or university) which do not affect his eligibility as a tennis player for such school.

Sec. 3. Any tennis player who is still eligible to play in any age category under 19 years of age will be permitted to participate in a tournament, match, or exhibition only if he is in good standing under amateur regulations.

Sec. 4. All other tennis players who accept the authority of the USLTA, and who are in good standing with, the USLTA shall be designated as PLAYERS.

Sec. 5. Both AMATEURS and PLAYERS shall play only in tournaments, matches, or exhibitions which are sanctioned or approved by the USLTA, and both AMATEURS and PLAYERS may compete in all such sanctioned or approved tournaments, matches, or exhibitions; provided, that PLAYERS may not participate in tournaments, matches, or exhibitions expressly limited to AMATEURS.

Essentially, what these rules do is this: They divide USLTA tennis players into two basic categories:

1. Those who play tennis for the love of the game and for its healthful recreational benefits, i.e., the *Amateur* who derives no pecuniary advantage from the game, and

2. Those who play tennis to earn money therefrom, i.e., the *player*—a non-amateur.

The new rules do not attempt to regulate the touring professionals who are under contract to the promoters, except to recognize that such touring professionals may play in ILTF sanctioned open tournaments.

The effects of the new rules concerning sanctioned tournaments are as follows:

Players, amateurs, and teaching professionals can play in any sanctioned tournament so long as they are enrolled with the USLTA and agree to its rules and regulations during the tournament.

Players, amateurs, and contract professionals (touring professionals) can compete in tournaments sanctioned as "Open" tournaments by the USLTA and the ILTF.

Tournaments may limit themselves to amateurs only by stating to their Section and to the USLTA that the tournament is for amateurs only.

Any tournament, in which players, amateurs, and teaching pros play, may give prize money in addition to trophies and expense money, if the tournament desires. In the event

that prize money is to be offered, the tournament sanction application must be amended with a full disclosure of the amount of prize money to be paid out.

5. Players and teaching pros may ask for and receive any amount of expense money that the tournament is willing to pay. *Amateurs may only receive the amount that they actually spend* during the tournament, and this is further qualified by the rule that it must be reasonable. *Example:* An amateur may receive travel money from his last tournament (but only to cover the class of travel *actually used*, as in the case of plane travel) and may be paid for his meals and hotel room. If he is housed in a hotel, he must accept their minimum accommodations and not rent the penthouse. *If he is housed and fed in a private home, he may only be paid travel expense.*

6. A Player must be over 19 years of age and must announce his intention to register as such to his Section.

7. Tournaments which give prize money must advise the Internal Revenue Service of the winners and the amount of prize money won.

In accordance with the provisions of No. 3, above, all SLTA tournaments having adult events were asked if they wished their tournaments limited to amateurs only. All such tournaments are clearly designated AMATEUR in the 1969 SLTA Tournament Schedule beginning on page 82. All tournaments with adult events not so designated, therefore, permit play by all except touring professionals.

ELIGIBILITY

All participants must be enrolled (registered) with USLTA or must apply for enrollment in order to compete in any sanctioned tournament and to be ranked. Applications for enrollment may be obtained from Tournament Directors, District Enrollment Chairmen, SLTA Enrollment Chairman, or SLTA Office. Adult (21 and over) fee is \$6 annually including subscription to "Tennis, U.S.A."; Junior (20 and under) fee is \$2.00 annually, plus \$2.00 for "Tennis, U.S.A." subscription, if desired. Identification cards will be mailed from USLTA office, 51 East 42nd Street, New York 10017.

Eighteen and under Boys and Girls shall not have reached their 18th birthdays before January 1 of the year of competition. Sixteen through 10 and under also shall not have reached the birthday of the age group in which they wish to compete before January 1 of the year of competition.

Eighteen and under—anyone born in 1950 or before is ineligible for 1969 play.

Sixteen and under—anyone born in 1952 or before is ineligible for 1969 play.

Fourteen and under—anyone born in 1954 or before is ineligible for 1969 play.

Twelve and under—anyone born in 1956 or before is ineligible for 1969 play.

Ten and under—anyone born in 1958 or before is ineligible for 1969 play.

Men's 35—open to men 35 years of age, or who become 35 during the calendar year.

Women's 35—open to women 35 years of age or who become 35 during the calendar year.

Men's Senior Divisions:

Senior—45 and over

Senior 50—50 and over

Senior 55—55 and over

Senior 60—60 and over

Senior 65—65 and over

Women's Senior Divisions:

Senior—40 and over

Senior 50—50 and over

SLTA RANKING REGULATIONS

In order to qualify for a Southern ranking in his or her respective division, a player must participate in the below stated number of tournaments.

MEN'S SINGLES

Southern Championships and three (3) other Southern tournaments; or five (5) Southern tournaments; or Southern Championships and three (3) out-of-section tournaments; or two (2) Southern tournaments and one (1) USLTA Championship; or Davis Cup play.

WOMEN'S SINGLES - BOYS' AND GIRLS 18 THRU 12 SINGLES

Southern Championships and two (2) other Southern tournaments; or four (4) Southern tournaments; or Southern Championships and three (3) out-of-section tournaments; or two (2) Southern tournaments and one (1) USLTA Championship; or Davis Cup and Wightman Cup play.

MEN'S AND WOMEN'S DOUBLES - BOYS' AND GIRLS' 10 SINGLES AND DOUBLES - BOYS' AND GIRLS' 18 THRU 12 DOUBLES - MEN'S AND WOMEN'S SENIOR SINGLES - MEN'S AND WOMEN'S 35 SINGLES - FATHER AND SON DOUBLES

Southern Championships and one (1) other Southern tournament; or three (3) Southern tournaments; or one (1) Southern tournament and two (2) out-of-section tournaments; or one (1) Southern tournament and one (1) USLTA Championship.

MEN'S AND WOMEN'S SENIOR DOUBLES - MEN'S AND WOMEN'S 35 DOUBLES

Southern Championships and one (1) other Southern tournament; or two (2) Southern tournaments; or one (1) Southern tournament and two (2) out-of-section tournaments; or one (1) Southern tournament and one (1) USLTA Championship.

INSUFFICIENT DATA

A player, or team, with an otherwise outstanding record but not qualifying as to number of tournaments. A "recognized" or "known" player, or team, is not sufficient; the record must be outstanding with only the number of tournaments lacking.

RELATIVE IMPORTANCE OF TOURNAMENTS

Southern Championships will be considered more important than any other tournament. For instance, if player A defeats player B in the Southern Championships but loses to player B in another Southern tournament, player A will be ranked above player B—other things being equal. USLTA Championships held within our geographical limits will be given less weight than Southern Championships but more weight than other Southern tournaments.

A state tournament which is non-closed will be given more weight than a closed state tournament.

Late season tournaments will be given more weight than early season tournaments except in the case of Southern and USLTA Championships. If player A defeats player B in June but loses to player B in August, player B will receive the higher ranking, other things being equal.

NOTES

All tournaments referred to must be "sanctioned." A player or team must have won at least one match; a good loss only is not sufficient to obtain a ranking even though the player has participated in the required number of tournaments.

The minimum tournament qualifications may be waived in exceptional cases by a majority vote of the Executive Committee of the SLTA upon recommendation of the Ranking Committee Chairman.

SLTA TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS

The following Tournament Regulations, taken in part from USLTA Tournament Regulations, shall be observed by all OFFICIALS AND PLAYERS in sanctioned tournaments held by clubs or associations belonging to the Southern Lawn Tennis Association.

1. The Officers of the Club holding a tournament will have full control over the details concerning the tournament. They may act as the Tournament Committee or may delegate this authority to others. The Committee shall select a Referee, with power to appoint a substitute, and he or his substitute must be present at all times when play is in progress. He may not umpire or participate in a match unless his substitute is present to act as Referee. In the best interests of tennis, a tournament committee shall have three or more members, so that, in the event a member's child is involved in disciplinary action, the committee will have the power to disqualify the offender after a hearing.

2. The Committee shall keep order and decide any questions arising out of the competition, except those concerning the rules (which are to be decided by the Referee), and will enforce all rules set forth below governing Conduct of Players and Spectators.

The Committee is responsible for the proper running of the tournament in all matters and, in so doing, must observe the following:

A. Prepare draw sheets in accordance with regulations. The making of the draw should ALWAYS be done where interested persons can watch the preparation. **UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES WILL ANY DRAW BE DONE SECRETLY AND BEHIND CLOSED DOORS.**

B. Follow proper seeding regulations: in all early season tournaments, falling before or during the first week of June, with no current year's tournament records available, the previous year's ranking (National, Sectional, State) must be used for seeding purposes. Following the first tournaments, the records of the current year must be considered, particularly in the younger age divisions.

C. Carefully review all instructions concerning preparation of the draw, particularly with regard to correct placement of byes and seeded players. (Rules regarding this are in the USLTA Yearbook and Guide and further instructional material is sent to tournament directors by the Sectional Office.)

D. See that no person is permitted to play his first-round match in any event unless he or she possesses a current USLTA card or has proof (receipt) that he has applied for one. Such notice shall be included in all entry blanks sent out in connection with the tournament, and said entry blanks will also state that forms for applying for such a card will be available at the tournament. *The Committee is responsible for making necessary arrangements for handling this activity during the tournament.*

The above provisions concerning USLTA cards are mandatory on all sanctioned tournaments, and there is no way that a Tournament Committee or any official can waive this requirement or choose not to enforce it.

The USLTA card number, or the word APPL (if the player has not received his number) **MUST BE ENTERED ON THE DRAW SHEETS** sent to the Sectional Office.

E. Prepare a complete schedule, post it, and maintain it throughout the tournament. **MATCHES MAY NOT BE POSTPONED OR DELAYED TO FAVOR ANY PLAYER.**

F. All players shall be limited to three events. No player will be forced to play more than three singles matches in one day; nor should he be scheduled to play more than 1 round in each event in which he is entered, unless inclement weather forces doubling up on matches. If, due to rain or other unforeseen circumstances, a player's presence in an event other than his age group is causing delay, that player may be defaulted from that division.

G. It is mandatory that the Tournament Director start each day's matches at a time as early as the courts are playable, and maintain a constant order of play throughout the day. When it is possible to do so, each player shall be advised, on completion of his match, as to the time of his next match. In the event of rain, the Tournament Director must advise players as to a probable re-starting time and must caution players to report at the time stipulated.

H. Junior and Boys' and Girls' matches should **ALWAYS** be scheduled so that a player will compete in his own age classification before playing in an older classification the same day.

I. Rules regarding rest periods after the second set of three-set matches must be observed in accordance with regulations as listed in the USLTA Yearbook and Guide. It is emphasized that men and Junior Boys (18) are *not allowed* a rest period after the second set of a three-set match, and *this rule cannot be waived by anyone.*

J. Consider the use of qualified persons to act as roving monitors during matches in Junior events. These monitors can watch for trouble-spots and can, by their presence, sometimes solve problems immediately. (See par. 1 F (2) below under Conduct of Players and Spectators.)

CONDUCT OF PLAYERS AND SPECTATORS

1. The highest type of sportsmanship is expected from every player. If a player is accompanied by a parent, coach, friend, or any other person, the same exemplary conduct is expected of them. USLTA and SLTA regulations specifically prohibit the following **AND THEY WILL NOT BE TOLERATED:**

A. No loud, abusive, or profane language, and no racquet throwing or slamming of balls.

B. Stalling. The rules on continuous play are quite clear: "No allowance may be made for natural loss of physical condition . . . Not even momentary 'rest,' other than the normal towel-off pause at changeover, is allowed for recovery from 'natural loss of physical condition (cramps, for example).'" (Quoted from Rules in USLTA Yearbook and Guide.) The rules allow one (1) minute for towel-off, drinking water, etc., during change of courts on odd games. This does not permit promiscuous and continued strolling to the net or back court to use towels or sip a drink between points or after completion of even-numbered games. **PLAYERS MUST TAKE CARE AT ALL TIMES NOT TO INTERRUPT PLAY OR TO DISTRACT OPPONENT IN ANY WAY.**

C. No player or players will make a comedy of a match, whether they be winning or losing.

D. Coaching or outside distractions. Spectators are expected to observe good manners at all times. They will not be permitted to coach, talk to the players, sit or stand near a court in such a manner as to provide a distraction to any of the players on the court. Neither will they cheer or clap in any way that is obviously distracting rather than applauding good play.

E. Line calls by unauthorized persons. No player will ask any spectator for assistance in making line calls, nor will any spectator volunteer to do so *unless asked by an official of the tournament.* If any player desires assistance in officiating his match, he should make his request to the Tournament Director; this can be done either before or during the match.

F. Cheating 1. *Every player is expected to call balls on his side as he would expect his balls to be called by his opponent on the other side.* This is "The Golden Rule" of tennis. Any ball falling on *any part* of a line is good, and calling such a ball "out" is cheating! Conversely, any "out" ball must be called instantaneously; otherwise, it is presumed good and in play. Avoid "late" calls.

2. A player suspected of cheating should be reported to the Tournament Director who should send a *responsible* observer to monitor his match. If found to be guilty of cheating, the player will be warned that a continuation of this practice *will result in his being defaulted in that match and removed from all other events in which he is entered in that tournament.* A full report will be submitted to the player's Sectional Association for any further disciplinary action deemed suitable.

G. Calling of "lets." Good sportsmanship calls for each player to do all in his means to see that a match is played properly, fairly, and under the best possible circumstances. When anything distracts a player, such as a ball from another court rolling onto the court area (including the back stop), an *immediate* "let" call must be made by the *first* player who sees the ball. In this connection, "immediate" call means that the "let" call is made promptly, before either an opponent has a chance to hit the return or before a return has gone out of play.

H. Positively no gambling, drinking, or other conduct (either on or off the court) that is not in the best interest of tennis will be tolerated.

2. Any alleged violations of the above, which are brought to the attention of the Referee, Tournament Director, or Tournament Committee, will be investigated by one of these officials and, upon verification, the player and/or spectator so involved will be given one warning. Upon the second offense, the player will be defaulted and the spectator removed. A full report will then be made to the player's Sectional Association and to the President of the Southern Lawn Tennis Association if the player's Section is other than the SLTA.

Any flagrant violations of these regulations or rules of conduct brought to the attention of the SLTA Executive Committee may, at the discretion of the Committee, result in the withdrawal of sanction from the Club or Association in question for such time as decided upon by the Committee, or in seasonal disqualification of a player involved in any misdemeanor.

SLTA PRESIDENT'S REPORT

Nineteen sixty-eight was an outstanding year in the growth and progress of the Southern Lawn Tennis Association. Following are a few highlights.

Charlotte, North Carolina, was responsible for staging the Davis Cup matches between the United States and Ecuador. Notwithstanding the adverse weather conditions, the attendance at the matches was good, with much of the credit going to Cliff Turner and his committees.

The newly-established Senior 50 division was inaugurated at Knoxville with the first USLTA Championships being held under the direction of Dr. Joe Garcia. The Atlanta team of Bitsy Grant and Tom Bird won the first National Doubles Championship in this division.

As in the years past, Bitsy Grant retained the No. 1 spot in the national ranking in the Senior 55 division by winning both the USLTA Clay Courts at Knoxville and the USLTA Grass Courts at Tuscaloosa.

Another Georgian, A. L. ("Red") Enloe from Decatur, was the winner of the first annual USLTA Senior 65 event held at Cape Coral, Florida. Teaming up with Hobart Wrobbel of Miami, he also shared the doubles crown in the same division.

Among other outstanding accomplishments of the year was Linda Tuero's reaching the finals of the National Clay Courts and her eventual national ranking of No. 8 in the Women's Division.

The Dr. and Mrs. Joe Garcia family of Knoxville, Tenn., through their contribution to tennis, were runners-up in the National Family of the Year contest.

The junior events were greatly expanded during the past year. Particularly impressive were the annual Sugar Bowl Tennis Championships which attracted close to 300 youngsters from all over the country.

The enrollments in the Southern showed about a 12% increase over the past year and hopefully should pass the 5,000 mark in 1969.
